

Quick Tips for Voting by Mail

Instructions For Voting

1. To vote for any candidate whose name is printed on this ballot, fill in the oval to the right of the candidate's name (from this ○, to this ●). Do not vote for more than the number of candidates to be elected to each office.
2. Use ONLY an ink pen (blue or black) to mark your ballot. Do not use red ink or a marker.
3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot, write the person's name on the blank line(s) (marked "write in") beside the proper title of office and fill in the oval to the right of the name (from this ○, to this ●).
4. Do not mark this ballot in any manner other than provided for and do not erase. If you spoil your ballot, request a new one from the County Clerk by calling 732-431-7790. If you mark your ballot in such a way that your intent is unclear, or if you vote for more than the number to be elected to an office, your vote for that office will not be counted.

AT NO TIME MAY ANYONE CAMPAIGN OR ELECTIONEER WHILE PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO COMPLETE YOUR MAIL-IN BALLOT.



VOTE YOUR BALLOT

Use black or blue pen. DO NOT USE RED INK OR A MARKER.

- Fill in the oval to the right of your choice.
- To make a write-in choice, fill in the oval and clearly print the name of the candidate.

INSERT YOUR BALLOT INTO THE CERTIFICATION ENVELOPE & COMPLETE THE CERTIFICATE

Place the ballot into this envelope and seal it.

- **Complete** and **Sign** the **Certificate of Mail-in Voter**. **DO NOT DETACH THE CERTIFICATE** from the envelope.
- If someone assists you in completing your ballot, they must complete the assistor portion.
Candidates, union representatives, & employers cannot be assistants.
- **NEW LAW!** Include your contact information in case you need to be contacted concerning your ballot.

CERTIFICATE OF MAIL-IN VOTER

FOR YOUR VOTE TO COUNT, you must complete the following information:

Signature of voter

Signature of person providing assistance

BE SURE TO SEAL BEFORE MAILING. DO NOT DETACH. USE A DAMP SPONGE OR CLOTH OR GLUE TO SEAL.



INSERT THE CERTIFICATION ENVELOPE INTO THE RETURN ENVELOPE

Place the certification envelope in the pre-addressed return envelope.

- **Make sure the TOP BARCODE** on the certification envelope **appears in the window**.
- If someone mails or delivers your ballot for you, they must complete the **Bearer Portion** in front of you before the ballot leaves your possession.

PLEASE MAKE SURE TOP BARCODE APPEARS IN WINDOW
